

Chromebook Acceptable Use Policy

This policy is intended to provide students and parents with the parameters for acceptable and use of Chromebooks issued by Brookfield Schools. Students using Brookfield-issued Chromebooks must use them in accordance with these established guidelines for the purpose of learning. The school will monitor Chromebook activities that take place both at school and at home using a variety of tools.

Please read the pledge below, and sign to demonstrate that you and your child have read, understand and agree to it.

- I will take care of my assigned device.
- I will never leave my device unattended.
- I will know where my device is at all times.
- I will keep food and beverages away from my device.
- I will charge by device's battery daily.
- I will not place decorations (such as stickers, markers, etc.) on the device.
- I will keep my charger at school or at home in a safe place.
- I will never loan out my device to other individuals.
- I will not disassemble any part of my device or attempt any repairs.
- I will only use my device in ways that are appropriate and educational, meeting the Brookfield expectations.
- I will not deface the serial number device sticker on any device.
- I understand that my device is subject to inspection at any time without notice and remains the property of Brookfield.

I agree to return the school's device and power supply at the end of each school year, or if the scholar transfers to another district.

I understand that all internet traffic on the device passes through the district's content filter, in school as well as off premises. All traffic can be reviewed for inappropriate use, and students are responsible for websites visited as well as Internet searches performed.

I understand the device is equipped with a camera. The network does not use the camera for anti-theft or any other purposes, and will not remotely activate the camera under any circumstances.



I understand that a lost or damaged chromebook will result in the following charges:

Lost Chromebook	\$250.00
Physical Damage(e.g. dropped , water, etc.)	\$250.00
Lost or Damaged Charger	\$50.00- \$100.00
Broken Screen or Hinge	\$50.00-\$100.00
Damaged Keyboard or Trackpad (e.g. missing keys)	\$55.00-\$100.00
Damaged Power, USB or Headphone Port	\$100.00
Physically Damaged Webcam or Speaker	\$50.00
Damaged or Lost Case	\$26.00

Note: Payment plan options will be offered upon request.

Brookfield Schools understands that technology devices/items can become defective, therefore all defective items that are not physically damaged will be repaired and/or replaced by the district at no cost to the Parent/Guardian.
